A department of the Metropolitan Government, MWS is funded by water, sewer, and stormwater rates and fees. With an operating budget of \$162 million and a six year capital budget close to \$3 billion, MWS is one of the largest public utilities in the southeast.

Serving over 220,000 customers across the region, our 1,100 employees continue to make MWS a leading utility. With two water treatment plants, three water reclamation facilities, over 3,000 miles of water distribution, and 2,900 miles of sewer collection mains, MWS maintains the highest standards for water quality.

MWS is also responsible for the vital link between this vibrant city and the Cumberland River and its tributaries through stormwater management.

THE POSITION

Located in the System Services Division of MWS, this position will be responsible for ensuring consistent and effective responses to both planned and emergency construction activities. The position will manage and supervise the Distribution and Collection Repair, First Investigation, and Restoration work groups, consisting of 70+ employees.

Typical Duties:

- Organizes, prioritizes and directs water and sewer construction operations for linear assets.
- Develops, monitors and maintains day-to-day operations for work groups.
- Ensures employees and activities adhere to all policies, procedures, standards, and specifications.
- Ensures work is performed in accordance with governing agencies, regulations, and best practices.
- Determines appropriate workloads, staff levels and schedules, providing ongoing support.
- Manages and plans for necessary equipment, tools, material and staff to accomplish work for all shifts.
- Fosters a collaborative team environment as a supervisor, providing coaching, mentoring and feedback.
- Serves as the primary liaison with other MWS Divisions.
- Provides technical and functional guidance to various internal and external stakeholders.
- Effectively uses associated software to plan, process, review and approve related work.
- Communicates and coordinates with other SSD work groups to ensure overall Division goals are met.
- Must be available for on-call rotations and after hours emergency response.





THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

- Demonstrated experience in construction activities related to potable water main and/or gravity main installation.
- Possesses strong written, verbal and interpersonal communication skills.
- Certifications in work zone traffic control, excavation safety and/or confined space entry.
- Collection systems or distribution license issued by the State of TN or similar license in another State.
- Knowledge of water main and sewer gravity design principles/practices.
- Demonstrated ability to establish priorities and execute work plans related to repair operations.
- Demonstrated ability to develop and foster a "customer first" culture.
- Proven understanding of managerial and administrative principles and practices.
- Proficient in use of word processing, spreadsheet, database and computerized maintenance management systems.



QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university in Engineering, Construction Management, or related field, and eight (8) years of construction management or water/sewer operations experience, including five (5) years in a supervisory capacity.
- Class D Driver's License

Note: Per Metro Ordinance NO. SO94-1078. All employees of the Metropolitan Government shall be residents of the State of Tennessee or become residents of the State within six (6) months of employment as a prerequisite to employment with the Metropolitan Government.
