Bidder/Vendor Certifications

Requirements

Contractors who apply or bid for an award of \$100,000 or more shall file the required certification

Any contract that uses federal funds to pay for construction work is a “federally assisted construction contract” and must include the equal opportunity certificate

The prospective participant certifies to the best of its knowledge and belief

The contractor certifies by signature below that it is not included on the list of persons created pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-12-106 of the Iran Divestment Act

Applicable Situations

Contracts for more than the Simplified Acquisition Threshold: All Contracts above \$50,000.00 or of your local threshold is lower.

Contracts over \$10,000

All individual projects under contracts that utilize at least \$10,000,000 of ARP funding

Must be included in contracts subject to the Davis-Bacon Act

Contracts awarded over \$100,000 involving the employment of mechanics or laborers
