Reimbursement

A reimbursement request for WIIP grants shall include only requests for actual, reasonable, and necessary expenditures required in the delivery of service described in the grant contract and identified in the Individual Project Budget. Reimbursement may not include any request for future expenditures. The grant contract term for a reimbursement request (§200.77) means the time during which the grant applicant may incur new obligations to carry out the work authorized in the grant contract. Grant applications will start on March 3, 2021 and end on September 30, 2026. Grant applicants may elect to end their grant term early, if all contract deliverables are complete and reports are submitted and approved.

- i) Investigation and Planning
 - The maximum allowable reimbursement is 80% of the individual project budget until the PER or Facilities Plan is received and approved by the Division of Water Resources.
- ii) Investigation, Planning and Design
 - (1) The maximum allowable reimbursement is 80% of the planning fees until the PER or Facilities Plan is **received and approved by the Division of Water Resources**.
 - (2) The maximum allowable reimbursement is 80% of the design fees until plans and specifications are received and approved by the Division of Water Resources.
- iii) Planning, Design, and Construction or Construction only
 - The maximum allowable reimbursement is 80% of the design fees until plans and specifications are received and approved by the Division of Water Resources.
 - (2) The maximum allowable reimbursement is 90% of the total project costs until construction is complete, the site has been inspected by the Division of Water Resources (or designated agent), the facilities are in proper operation, and the project has been approved by the Division.
