General Summary/Objective

Assist in the operation of the water treatment lant to produce clean and safe drinking water. Assist in the operation and maintenance of the water treatment plant, ensuring that the water produced meets state and federal standards. Assist in monitoring and controlling equipment processes, performing regular maintenance, and keeping detailed records.

Essential Functions

- Assist in operating the water treatment plant to produce clean and safe drinking water.
- Assist in the monitoring and control of equipment and processes, making adjustments as needed to maintain quality standards.
- Assist in maintaining proper water levels in storage tanks.
- Assist with the performance of routine maintenance and repairs on plant equipment and machinery.
- Assist with the collection and analysis of water samples to ensure that the water meets state and federal standards.
- Assist in maintaining accurate records of operations, maintenance, and testing results.
