AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 50-7-302 and Section 58-2-106, relative to emergencies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 50-7-302(a), is amended by designating the existing language as subdivision (a)(1) and adding the following as a new subdivision (a)(2):
 - (2) Upon declaration of an emergency pursuant to § 58-2-107, the provisions of subdivisions (a)(1)(C)-(a)(1)(E) are suspended to the extent necessary to allow the commissioner the discretion to amend such reporting requirements upon receiving appropriate federal guidance. Such a suspension is limited to eligible claimants who reside or work in counties for which this state has requested a major disaster declaration.
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 58-2-106(b), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision (b)(19) and redesignating the existing subdivision (b)(19) accordingly:
 - (19) Have authority to assist a political subdivision or local emergency management agency with recovery from disasters and emergencies on public property at the request of the political subdivision or agency.
 - SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
