AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-44-110, relative to agendas for meetings of governing bodies.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-44-110, is amended by deleting the language "state governing body or a local government legislative body" wherever it may appear and substituting "state governing body or a local governmental body", and is further amended by deleting the language "may" in subsection (d) and substituting "shall".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-44-110, is amended by deleting subsection (e) and substituting the following language:

- (e) As used in this section, "local governmental body" means:
- (1) The legislative body of an incorporated city or town, a metropolitan government, or a county;
  - (2) A regional or municipal planning commission;
  - (3) A board of zoning appeals;
  - (4) A public utility board;
  - (5) An industrial development corporation board of directors;
  - (6) A housing authority;
  - (7) A regional or municipal airport authority;
  - (8) A county election commission; and
- (9) The budget committee of a legislative body of an incorporated city or town, a metropolitan government, or a county.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
